Swimming

Swimming lessons will be taking place during this term. Lessons will be held on Mondays from 11am- 12pm and will begin on Monday 9th January. Lessons will continue for 10 weeks, excluding 6th February, with the final week being Monday 20th March. A bus has been arranged to transport the pupils to and from the Monaghan Leisure Complex.

The cost of lessons will be €7.50 per pupil, (this includes €4.20 for the swimming lesson and €3.30 for the bus.) Lessons can be paid for individually each week or in total at the end. Just let Lila know if you wish for her to send you a bill at the end of the lessons.

If your child is absent on swimming day, the swimming lesson does not need to be paid for but we would appreciate payment for the bus as its cost must be covered regardless of numbers.

We also require a parent or guardian of Junior and Senior Infants pupils to come along to assist with changing and dressing before and after the lesson as teachers are unable to help pupils with changing. Pupils from 1st class upwards can get changed by themselves.

Children will need to have a swimming hat. Children will also have their feet checked for verrucas on the first day, therefore, you may like to send swimming socks if you think your child has a verruca.

We hope everyone enjoys their swimming lessons this term.
